PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

- While studying to become a specialist: additional training in fluoroangiography and diagnostic use of ultrasounds at the National Ophthalmology Centre at XV-XX Hospital (Paris), under Professor Massin.
- 1974: (January to March) volunteer surgeon in Pakistan: Shikarpur Eye Hospital (performed over 500 procedures).
- In private practice since 1974:
 - Brussels Surgical Institute (Square Marie-Louise) from November 1973 to November 1993 (head of the ophthalmology department from 1987 to 1993).
 - Park Leopold Clinic since 1979, head of the ophthalmology department since 2006.
 - Training in microsurgery in 1975 in Nantes under Professors Quéré and Baikoff.
 - Training in treating strabismus: Professor Cüppers (Tübingen University) and Dr Sevrin.
 - Training in the use of intraocular implants in 1976 and 1977 with pioneers in the area, Dr C. Binkhorts and Dr P. Choyce.
 - Training in phakoexeresis in 1978, under Professor Arnott (Charing Cross Hospital, London).
- Dr Reiter was **one of Belgium's pioneers in implanting intraocular lenses and using phakoexeresis** – he has used these techniques since 1977 at the Brussels Surgical Institute and since 1979 at the Park Leopold Clinic.
- He has practiced refractory surgery since 1980 (radial keratotomy) and also excimer laser and Lasik surgery since 1998.

- The anterior segment: cataracts, glaucoma and refractory surgery;
- Strabismus and oculomotor paralysis;
- Eyelid surgery.
